1994, revised 2013**

Maps from the F. B. Kegley Collection were originally housed and catalogued in the early 1970s. In 2013 they were rehoused in acid-free folders and entered into the PastPerfect database. The original arrangement was maintained and the original numbering system. The PastPerfect (PP) reflects the accession number of the collection 1968.7; maps are numbered sequentially.
